### [Ticket Overview]

- Please show the pass clearly to the staff when boarding or getting off.
- Additional charges apply for special express fare such as for the Romancecar and other limited express trains, the express bus (Gotemba-Kawaguchiko Line), and the Fuji Tozan Densha.
- Note that if you travel outside or past designated areas, you are required to pay the fare for that portion.
- Pass holders enjoy unlimited boarding along the designated areas.
- Pass holders are not permitted to board regular tourist buses.
- Pass holders are not permitted to board Izu-Hakone Bus.
- Pass holders are not permitted to board highway bus (Chuo Expressway).
- Odakyu Highway Bus will not be available when the bus is full, as priority is given to those with designated tickets.
- Service may be interrupted in the event of poor weather in the Hakone area, in which case fare is refunded to pass holders at the Odakyu Sightseeing Service Center. (To be eligible for a refund, you must not have boarded any of the suspended transport services).
- Note that the Pass expires in three days after purchase at the time the relevant transportation services close for the day, regardless of the time of day you started your trip.
- The Pass will be collected at the final station of your journey.

### For greater comfort and speed! Reserve a seat on the Limited Express Romancecar!

A small extra charge in addition to your Fuji Hakone pass, allows you the use of the Odakyu Limited Express Romancecar. (One way charge from Shinjuku to Hakone-Yumoto is 1,200 yen per adult.)  
\*You can save 50 yen if you use the e-Romancecar online service to purchase your electronic limited express ticket.

Use the e-Romancecar webpage to buy the Limited Express ticket at any time or place.

- Possible to buy from either smartphone or PC
- No need to register membership number
- Pay by credit card

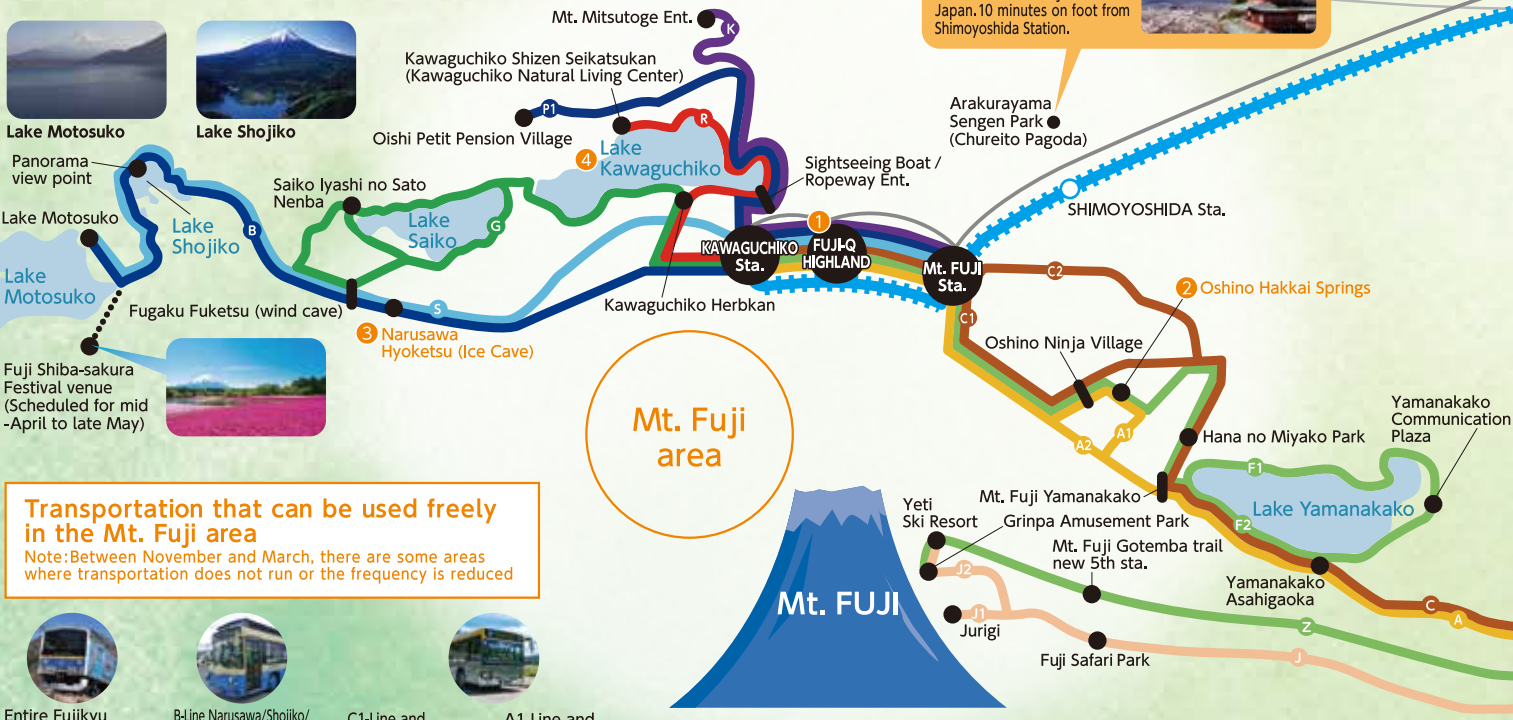

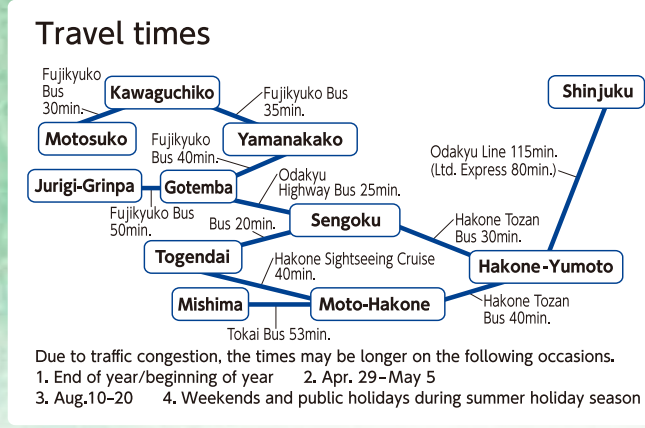




# FUJI HAKONE AREA MAP

### Mt. Fuji Viewpoints

Visible from the Hakone Ropeway, between Owakudani and Ubako stations.

Visible from the Hakone Sightseeing Cruise at the Hakonemachi and Moto-hakone end.

Visible from the observation deck at Onshi-Hakone-Koen Park in Hakonemachi.

Visible from Mishima Skywalk, the longest pedestrian suspension bridge in Japan.

**Transportation to these areas other than using the Odakyu Line**  
\* Separate charges apply

- JR Chuo Line**  
From Shinjuku Sta. to Otsuki Sta.
- Highway bus (Chuo Expressway)**  
From Shinjuku Highway Bus Terminal → Kawaguchiko Sta./Fujikyu Highland/Mt. Fuji Sta.
- Odakyu Highway Bus**  
Shinjuku Expressway Bus Terminal → Tomei-Gotemba (unlimited between Tomei-Gotemba and Gotemba Sta.)

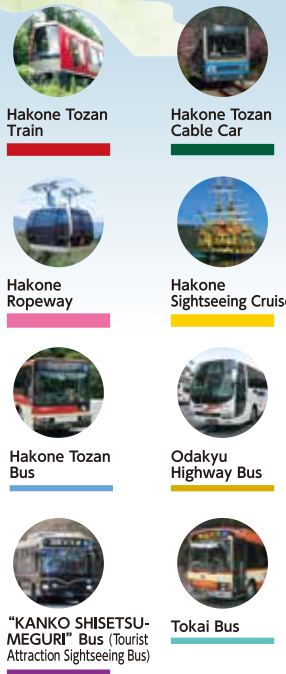
