Announcing the renewal of the convenient and economical

“Fuji Hakone Pass” discount excursion ticket!

On sale starting from April 1, 2016 (Fri.)

The excursion areas allowing passengers to get on and off as they desire have been expanded, and now there are 2 types of passes to choose from: “Shinjuku-departure” and “Odawara-departure”.

ODAKYU ELECTRIC RAILWAY Co., Ltd., FUJIKYUKO Co., Ltd., and Keio Bus Higashi Co., Ltd. will be launching a renewed “Fuji Hakone Pass” on April 1, 2016.

The Fuji Hakone Pass is a discount excursion ticket valid for a 3-day period, allowing passengers to go on round-trip excursions in the popular Fuji and Hakone areas with just one ticket. Even now, it is frequently used by many visitors from foreign countries. With this new and improved pass, the available range of transportation in the Fuji area has been expanded to include access to popular sightseeing locations like the Arakurayama Sengen Park. There are also 2 types of passes to choose from, “Shinjuku-departure” and “Odawara-departure”, to accommodate visitors’ travel schedules. The renewed Fuji Hakone Pass has become even more convenient, so visitors can enjoy 2 popular and famous sightseeing areas with convenient access from Tokyo.

 - (2) Odawara-departure: 5,650 yen for adults, 2,820 yen for children
*Does not include one-way tickets between Shinjuku and Odawara, and tickets for the Chuo Highway Bus.

6. Content [Same for Shinjuku-departure and Odawara-departure passes]
A discount excursion ticket valid for 3 days to take excursions in the Fuji and Hakone areas.
It includes exclusive privileges for over 90 facilities in the Fuji and Hakone areas.
 - (1) Sections where passengers are free to get on and off as they desire
 - [Hakone area]
 - ① Hakone Tozan Train
 - ② Hakone Tozan Bus (designated sections)
 - ③ Hakone Tozan Cable Car
 - ④ Hakone Ropeway

 - ⑥ Odakyu Hakone Highway Bus (designated sections)
 - ⑦ Hakone Tozan "KANKO SHISETSU-MEGURI" Bus (Tourist-facilities Round Bus)

(2) Exclusive privileges

The Fuji Hakone Pass can be presented to receive exclusive privileges at over 50 facilities in the Hakone area and over 40 facilities in the Fuji area, for a total of over 90 locations.

[Only for Shinjuku-departure]

Getting on and off is only allowed 1 time each way for the following sections during the valid period.

① Odakyu Line Between Shinjuku and Odawara

*If using the Limited Express “Romancecar”, the purchase of a separate express ticket for 890 yen (between Shinjuku – Odawara and Hakone-Yumoto) will be required.

② Chuo Highway Bus Between Lake Kawaguchi and Shinjuku Highway Bus Terminal

*Use of the Keio Dentetsu Bus or Fujikyuko Bus is allowed.

*Since all seats are reserved, advance reservations will be required.

*From April 4, Shinjuku Expressway Bus Terminal is relocated to Shinjuku Station south exit (Busta Shinjuku)

7. Recommended routes using the Fuji Hakone Pass

[When using Shinjuku-departure]

① Shinjuku – Odawara – Hakone area excursion – Gotemba Station – Fuji area excursion – Kawaguchiko Station – Shinjuku

② Shinjuku – Kawaguchiko Station – Fuji area excursion – Gotemba Station – Hakone area excursion – Odawara – Shinjuku

[When using Odawara-departure]

① Odawara – Hakone area excursion – Gotemba Station – Fuji area excursion

② Odawara – Lake Kawaguchi – Hakonemachi – Mishima → Kansai, etc.
