Kanagawa Prefecture × Keio University × Odakyu Electric Railway's inbound measures in joint industry, government and academia cooperation Hakone model sightseeing course for Muslim tourists ~ Introducing a hot spring tour that incorporates information

on items such as food and prayer on our website ~

Odakyu Electric Railway Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Shinjuku Ward, Tokyo; President: Yamaki Toshimitsu), in cooperation with Kanagawa Prefecture and Keio University, has created the model sightseeing course in Hakone aimed at Muslim tourists, which will be introduced on the Odakyu Electric Railway's global site from 30th March, 2016 (Wed.).

Background of the implementation

The number of foreign visitors to Japan reached 19.74 million people in 2015, a trend that is steadily increasing in recent years. It is expected that the number of Muslim tourists from countries such as Malaysia and Indonesia will increase in the future.

Muslim tourists may require special consideration for religious reasons, such as their daily prayers and specific dietary restrictions (pork, alcohol, etc.).

Accordingly, through a cooperation between industry, government and academia together with Kanagawa Prefecture and Keio University, we have created the model sightseeing course in Hakone aimed at Muslim tourists.

To create this recommended tour route, we planned and conducted an actual trial of the tour route with a Muslim husband and wife couple from Indonesia as our models, all based on cooperation from Kanagawa Prefecture and Keio University. The guide incorporates necessary information for Muslim tourists, such as about prayer at hot spring facilities and restaurants, and presentation of menus which do not contain pork. It will be introduced on the Odakyu Electric Railway's global site from 30th March (Wed.), offering information on the attractive popular sightseeing spot "Hakone" toward Muslim tourist.

- · Dinner (Japanese Cuisine) and overnight at Odakyu Hotel de Yama

- Explore "Hakone-jinja Shrine"
- Art appreciation at "Narukawa Art Museum" (including Japanese-style paintings)
