Odawara Chochin Summer Festival (summer lantern festival) [July 29-30]

Odawara lanterns made by elementary school students will be on display, a lantern dance contest will be held at the main venue at Odawara Castle Park, and other attractions to be held including a mikoshi parade where local residents will be hoisting portable shrines.

Kosui-Matsuri (lake festival)

Food stands will be set up, a taiko drum festival held by the locals, along with Soran Odori dance and the floating of paper lanterns. Fireworks will also be on display.

Kojiri Ryujinsai Festival

After Shinto rituals, a fireworks show will be put on during a bonfire. Around 2,500 fireworks will be launched, including some from the surface of the water.

Torii Yaki Festival

Fireworks will be set off as lanterns float and a torii is burned on the surface of the lake. The festival will be held in the Hakonemachi-ko port area where the finish line for the Hakone Ekiden is located.
