

Hakone Tozan Line resumes Operation between Hakone-Yumoto Station and Gora Station from July 23rd, 2020 (Thursday/Holiday)

Hakone Tozan Railway Co., Ltd. of the Odakyu Group has suspended the operation for a long time between Hakone-Yumoto Station and Gora Station due to damage from the Typhoon Hagibis in October 2019.

However, due to the progress of the recovery work, we decided the restart date of the commercial operation on all lines as follows.

In the Hakone Region, the typhoon caused enormous damage. However, by resuming all Hakone Tozan Line operations, the Hakone sightseeing trip route (the Hakone Golden Course) will be fully restored.

Hakone Tozan Line between Hakone-Yumoto Station and Gora Station is the steep grade railway that runs steep slope while switching back at three locations such as stations.

By resuming operation on all lines, we will contribute to the development of Hakone tourism through revitalizing the areas along our lines and helping the guests to memorize their experiences.

* From July 9th, trial operation has started between Hakone-Yumoto Station and Gora Station.
