

【Topics】 Discount passes can now be purchased and used on smartphones

On October 1, 2021, Odakyu Electric Railway Co., Ltd. started a service that allows customers to purchase and use discount passes, such as the “Hakone Freepass”, on their smartphones.

This service is a browser format that does not require an app download, and you can purchase tickets anytime and anywhere on your smartphone until just before departure.

You don't need to exchange the ticket you bought for a paper ticket. When you get on and off a vehicle, you can use the ticket by showing your smartphone screen to a station attendant or a bus driver.

- Digital Hakone Freepass
- Digital Tanzawa-Oyama Freepass

※ As of October 1, “Digital Hakone Freepass” and “Digital Tanzawa-Oyama Freepass” are available in English.

※ The prices of the digital tickets are the same as the paper “Hakone Freepass” and the “Tanzawa-Oyama Freepass”, respectively.

Access the official site of Odakyu Electric Railway from your smartphone and tap the “Purchase a digital ticket” button at the bottom of the smartphone screen. Then you will be taken to a digital ticketing site (EMot Online Tickets).
