

Visit Enoshima and Kamakura by Limited Express Romancecar

The Romancecar has reserved seating only for travel to Fujisawa and Enoshima, and is fast and comfortable!

Additional limited express surcharge is required for the Romancecar.



If you have an Enoshima / Kamakura Freepass from Shinjuku, only the additional limited express surcharge of 750 yen is required.

Discounted excursion ticket Enoshima / Kamakura Freepass, 1,640 yen from Shinjuku*



750 yen (one way) for limited express surcharge between Shinjuku and Katase-Enoshima

*For an Enoshima / Kamakura Freepass starting elsewhere than Shinjuku: for example, with an Enoshima / Kamakura Freepass from Fujisawa traveling one-way by Romancecar between Shinjuku and Katase-Enoshima takes a normal fare of 610 yen plus 750 yen for the limited express surcharge.
*You can save 50 yen if you use the Odakyu's digital ticket purchase website (EMot Online Tickets) to purchase your electronic limited express ticket.

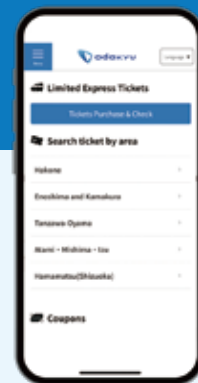
Buying digital tickets and limited express tickets is easy and convenient with EMot Online Tickets!

How to buy and use Limited Express Romancecar tickets

Click on "Tickets Purchase & Check" on the home page to book or purchase limited express tickets. Once you have purchased a digital limited express ticket, you do not need to change it for a paper ticket. You can use the digital ticket to travel with.

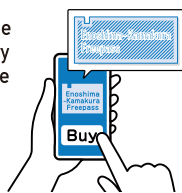
Important points to note : *Please use a smartphone to purchase limited express tickets (They cannot be purchased using a PC or tablet PC) *Limited express tickets can be purchased for up to 8 people at one time *You will need to enter your credit card details to purchase tickets



How to buy and use Digital Enoshima/Kamakura Freepass

STEP 1 Access the purchase site

Access the ticket site and enter the necessary information to make the purchase



STEP 2 Display the ticket

Access your "My page" or the ticket page from the email you received at the time of purchase, and display the ticket



STEP 3 Scan the 2D code or present the ticket screen to the staff

At locations where 2D code readers are installed, please scan the 2D code. If there is no 2D code readers such as on a bus, please present your ticket screen to the staff



Important points to note : *Please note that digital tickets cannot be used without the necessary communication environment (WiFi, etc.) *You will need one smartphone per person to use digital tickets (PCs and tablet PCs cannot be used for this) *If you do not have a smartphone, please purchase a paper ticket at an Odakyu Sightseeing Service Center or ticket vending machine

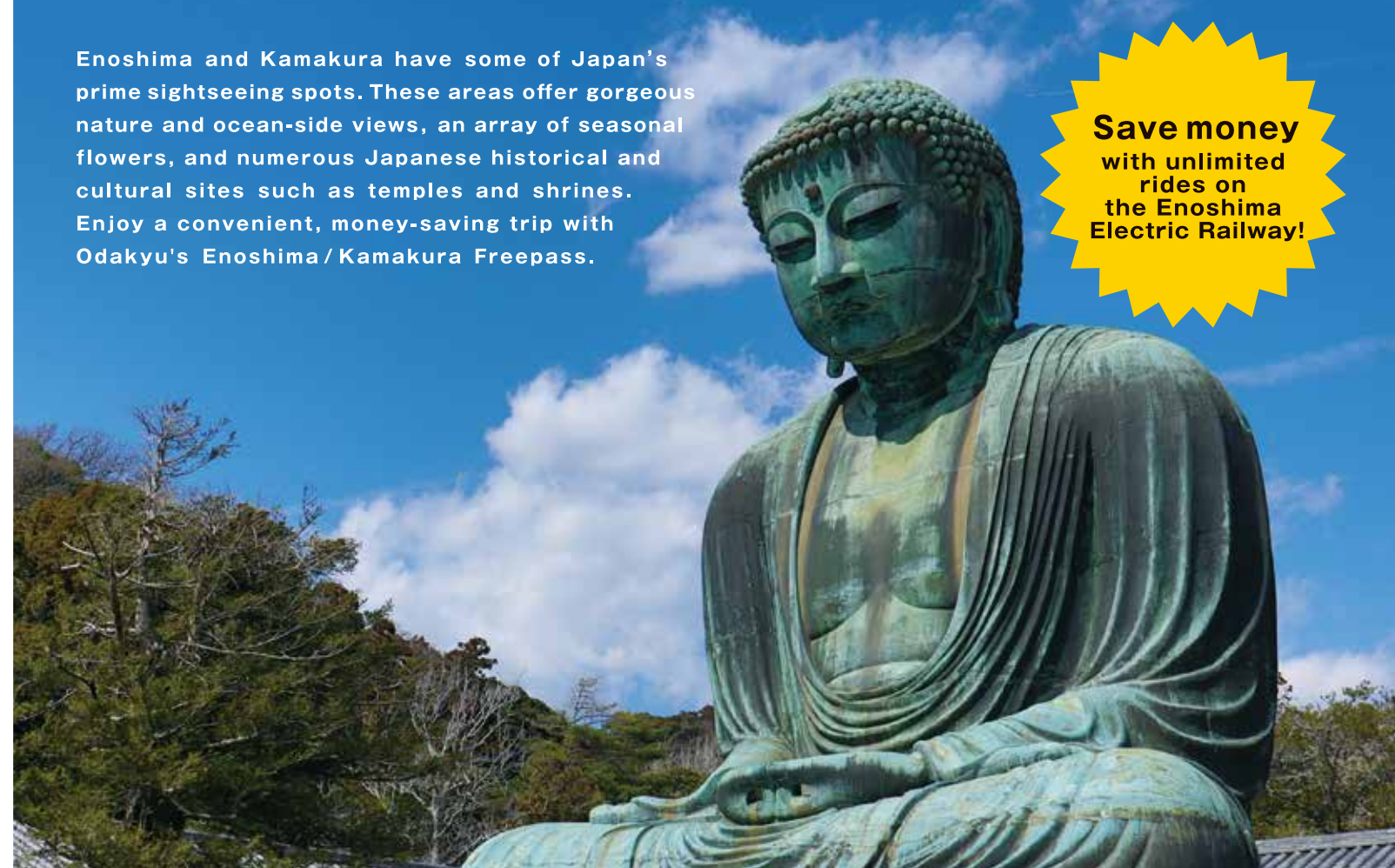

Save money with unlimited rides on the Enoshima Electric Railway!



● Round-trip travel on the Odakyu Line + unlimited use of Enoden (all lines) and Odakyu Line (Fujisawa ⇄ Katase-Enoshima)!

*Additional fare is required if boarding outside of or traveling beyond designated areas.

- Does not include the Limited Express Romancecar surcharge. Please buy a limited express ticket if you use the Romancecar.
- Good for only one round-trip from the departure station to Fujisawa.
- The Enoshima / Kamakura Freepass can be purchased starting one month prior to the date of travel.

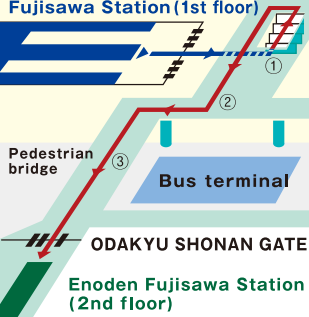

- ① Come out the Odakyu Line ticket gate and proceed to the second floor, where you will see a flight of stairs.
- ② Walk up the stairs and walk in the direction away from the JR lines.
- ③ Cross the bridge.

Fujisawa Station is currently under construction, so please check the information at the station when transferring to the Enoden.

2 Kotoku-in

(Great Buddha of Kamakura)



Since it was constructed some 750 years ago, the hall housing the Great Buddha was subject to damage in repeated natural disasters, and as a result the Buddha now sits outdoors. It measures approximately 11.3 meters in height.

1 Tsurugaoka Hachimangu



This shrine dates back to 1063 C.E., but it acquired its current appearance by order of Minamoto Yoritomo, founder of the Kamakura Shogunate. As such it has been an object of faith for the samurai class.

2 Kotoku-in

(Great Buddha of Kamakura)

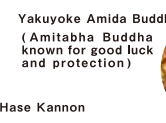
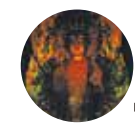


Kamakura Museum of Literature ★

3 Hasedera Temple (Hase Kannon) ★



Hasedera Temple was built in 736 C.E. Its primary image, revered since ancient times, is an 11-faced Kannon standing 9.18 meters in height. The temple's early-summer hydrangea are also a favorite tourist spot.



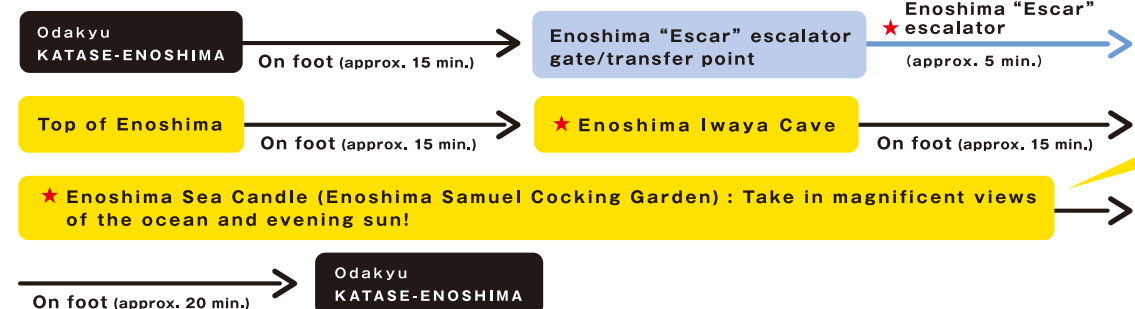
