Recommended Spots in the **Hakone Area**

Conveniently accessible from downtown Tokyo, Hakone is a very popular tourist destination. In September, after the hottest part of the summer has passed and the weather becomes a bit more bearable, many people like to do cultural activities such as visiting art museums or doing a bit of reading.



The Hakone Open-Air Museum

彫刻の森美術館

An open-air museum that showcases around 120 artworks spread across the approximately 70,000 square meter verdant space. It features interactive artworks for children, a natural hot spring foot bath, cafés, and more.

Access

2-minute walk from Chokokuno-mori Station



Hakone Venetian Glass Museum

箱根ガラスの森美術館

Combining a beautiful garden with a building modeled on an aristocrat's mansion, this is a museum specializing in exhibits of Venetian glass and modern glass art. The harmonization of the natural scenery with the glasswork is exquisite.

Access

About 25 minutes from Hakone-Yumoto Station via Hakone Tozan Bus bound for Togendai to "Hyoseki/Hakone-garasunomori-mae," and then a short walk to the museum



Hakone Honbako

This isn't just an accommodation facility: it houses around 12,000 books published in Japan and around the world. There are bookshelves all over the facility, and you can pick up and read the books as you like.

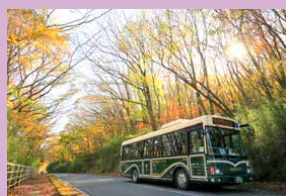
Access

Kitakamakura Old Private House Museum

北鎌倉 古民家ミュージアム

This exhibition space is made out of a remodeled private home built more than 100 years ago. In this building that preserves the atmosphere of Kamakura in days gone by, you can enjoy a variety of exhibits.

Access

2-minute walk from Kita-Kamakura Station

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Fujiko-F-Fujio Museum (Kawasaki City)

This museum exhibits the original drawings of, and documents related to, Fujiko F Fujio, author of the world-renowned manga Doraemon. Entry is by reservation only, with the date and time set in advance.



Access

16-minute walk from Mukogaoka-yuen Station



Taro Okamoto Museum of Art (Kawasaki City)

川崎市岡本太郎美術館

This museum preserves and exhibits the works of the artist Taro Okamoto, who was active in the 1940s and 80s. Being located in a large green area, it will also allow you to enjoy the rich natural scenery.

Access

17-minute walk from Mukogaoka-yuen Station

Hakone Pirate Ship "Chartered Sunset Cruise"

An intense pirate show and food event on the Hakone Pirate Ship. In addition to sampling meat and cheese, delicious wine and more, passengers can expect an extravagant entertainment show!

Place: Onboard the Hakone Pirate Ship (Royal II)

Reitai-sai at Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine

Place: Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine

This is the most important festival at Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine, and has been held once a year for the past eight centuries. Visitors can witness mikoshi (portable shrine) parades on the 15th.

Access

10-minute walk from Kamakura Station



Mid Sep → Early Nov

Eno-Fes

Place: Enoden Line Area

All sorts of events, from hula dancing to photography exhibits, can be enjoyed at spots along the Enoshima Electric Railway (Enoden) line. From late October to early November, around 8,000 candles will light up Enoshima Island.

Access

Along the track between Kamakura Station and Enoshima Station



Sep. 14 • Sep. 15

Odawara Essa Hoi Festival

Place: Specially installed stage inside Odawara Castle and other locations

A festival that "remixes" the famous Yosakoi dance from Kochi Prefecture in a uniquely "Odawara" style. Around 40 teams, with a total of about 1,000 members, will gather from around the city and beyond to show their dancing skills.

Access

10-minute walk from Odawara Station



Sep. 28 • Sep. 29

The 46th Fujisawa Citizen's Festival

Place: Around Fujisawa Station and around Fujisawa Civic Hall

One of the greatest events in Fujisawa City, planned, orchestrated and participated in by citizens of Fujisawa. Visitors can enjoy parades, stage events, a stall village, and more.

Access

1-minute walk from Fujisawa Station

Hakone Freepass

Valid Period/2 days or 3 days

This is the pass to get maximum enjoyment in the Hakone area. It comes with a return ticket from Shinjuku to Odawara, and provides unlimited access to 8 rides in the Hakone area such as the Hakone Ropeway and the Hakone Pirate Ship!

Hakone Kamakura Pass

Valid Period/3 days

Unlimited access to Hakone, Enoshima and Kamakura with this one ticket!

- ① Unlimited use of Odakyu trains on the entire Odakyu network, including the Odakyu Odawara Line, Odakyu Enoshima Line and Odakyu Tama Line.
- ② Hakone Area: 8 Rides in the Hakone area (the same as the Hakone Freepass)
- ③ Unlimited use of Enoden trains between Fujisawa and Kamakura.
